Because it incorporates a telephone network, Xenon offers free calls between residents throughout the site.

Dispersed alarms are supported by a range of Telecare sensors and alarms.

The system prioritises calls to ensure that emergency calls are not delayed.

Information about the type of call is provided on the warden's handset in an emergency.

Building alarm systems such as fire, intruder and door entry can be integrated into the system.

Door entry and warden call can be provided in one system to simplify installation.

Video door entry facilities can be provided through a video handset for wardens.
